Application form (Kobe University form) ■ On-line Student Visa Application for COE (Certificate of Eligibility). <p>Nominated exchange students will receive an email sent from a send-only email address (intlcesr@office.kobe-u.ac.jp) with a link to access the on-line application form arranged by Kobe University after the nomination periods (around November for Spring semester, around May for Fall semester).</p> <p>Please refer to COE online application form appearance and instructions for detail.</p> <p>The applicant will be requested to upload the following materials to the COE online application:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Digital ID Photo <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The ID photo should be taken within the last 3 months. ID photo MUST NOT same as your passport. The photo must meet all specifications with the instruction. 2. Passport ID Page 3. Proof of Financial Support in English or Japanese <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Bank balance certificate of yourself or your supporter's If you chose "scholarship" as your financial proof, need to submit a copy of an official document in English proving that the applicant will receive the scholarship/ grant. <p>After you filled out the COE application, we will apply for your COE on your behalf, and your COE will be issued in around 1 to 3 months depending on the congestion of the immigration office. As soon as receiving your COE, we will send it to your home university, not to each student. Please contact the nearby Japanese embassy or consulate for visa application after receiving your COE.</p> <p>Students who do not receive any email in the expected period are advised to check their e-mail folders including SPAM or advertisement mailbox because it could fail to reach your main inbox.</p> <p>Please note that the COE application will not guarantee your entry into Japan as an exchange student.</p>

<p>Insurance and Medical Assistance Service</p> <p>All students are mandatory to join all these 4 during your stay.</p> <p>University insurance</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. National Health Insurance (JPY 2,000/month) The National Health Insurance System in Japan reduces individuals' medical costs. 2. Personal Accident Insurance for Students Pursuing Education and Research (PAS) (JPY 1,000) covers accidents and injuries during University events and classes. 3. Comprehensive Insurance for Student's Lives Coupled with PAS for International (JPY 1,110 or more, depending on the package selected) This covers accidents that can happen during your daily life including off-campus. 4. Inbound Medical Assistance Service (IMAS) (JPY 1,300) The medical assistance service during your stay in Kobe.
<p>Vaccination</p>	<p>Kobe University has adopted Measles and Rubella Registration Policy, and all newly enrolled students must submit a certificate demonstrating inoculation and an antibody test against measles and rubella at the medical examination held at Kobe University. Those who do not certificate are required to take an antibody test in Japan.</p>
<p>Medical Support Consultation</p>	<p>For students with chronic conditions and disabilities (physical, developmental, or mental), if you let us know <u>in advance</u>, we will make preparations to support your medical needs, if any, during your stay. Please contact us (bkyomu@b.kobe-u.ac.jp) for the procedure.</p>
